Abrash is our newest wall-to-wall carpet style that exhibits striation of colour as nature defines and it is customised to your exact palette. In nature, colours merge and flow in surfaces such as ice, rock or earth, forming sweeping and unpredictable movement of colour in shades of light and darkness. At CRONZ, we have taken that as inspiration and designed a carpet to reflect this seemingly uncontrollable movements in a predictable way. Our design team have developed a design to distribute any colour in variety of shades and combinations, giving the effect of the movement. With us, however, it is controlled to the most-minute detail and because of that, each carpet is one-of-a-kind and utterly customised. Select three tonal colours, or two tonal and one contarsting colour, to form the unique striation. Abrash is made out of singles yarn of pure New Zealand wool, but it can also be combined with silk for sheen and elegance. No matter which fibre or combination of sibres is selected, Abrash is tufted and shorn to be high density, the highest quality custom carpet with a luxurious plush finish.

#### **COLOUR**

Custom colour of your choice.

#### DISCLAIMER

Dimensions may vary by up to 3% due to the tufting process so please specify the maximum or minimum dimensions when ordering the carpet or rug. For carpet installation, please allow extra 5-10% for fitting tolerance, depending on the room's size and shape.

Please note that variations in colour and texture may occur between batches of yarn and dye baths. All carpets and rugs, irrespective of their colour or finish, are subjected to shading and cut pile carpets may be subject to pile reversal which is not a manufacturing fault, but an inherent characteristic of these flooring surfaces.

#### SIZE

Abrash carpet is manufactured to specific room measurements, or according to a supplied floor plan. Rugs are also available, in a custom size of your choice.

MOST COMMON RUG SIZES are 2000 x 3000 mm,  $2500 \times 3500$  mm,  $3000 \times 4000$  mm, 2000 mm diameter round, 2500 mm diameter round,  $800 \times 4500$  mm (runner size).

#### **CARE ADVICE**

It is common for every new wool rug to shed fibers so please do not be alarmed. The majority of the shedding will occur in the first few months. Do not rub fresh stains as rubbing only pushes the stain deeper into the fibers. Make sure to attend to any spills immediately, and blot up liquids with plenty of paper towels. Regular vacuuming is the most efficient way to remove surface dust and prevent build-up of material that could harm the carpet. We recommend cleaning the carpet by professional carpet cleaners every 18 months. Cleaning by hot water extraction (steam cleaning) can produce excellent results provided that it is carried out by a competent operator.

Make sure to rotate rugs regularly to ensure even wear and protect them from prolonged periods of direct sunlight.
