

SUNBURST PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS



Sunburst (previously called Radiating Bars) is a bespoke round rug tufted in 100% New Zealand wool in your choice of colour, using the '3D Texturing' technique as a demonstration of the unlimited possibilities that the tufting method, bespoke machinery and CRONZ can offer to create unique textures and finishes. The idea to create this rug came from the desire to achieve a 3D design in cut pile. We were able to accomplish a 3D structure in loop pile in the past but the cut pile surface is a bit more difficult to manage, and requires adjusting the height of two yarn legs instead of one (some tufting basics: the needle inserts yarn into the backing cloth and can either form a loop or cut the thread in two and form a cut pile). The 3D image of the rug was drawn in a vector-based software first, then generated to a machine program for tufting. After many trials (and errors), the tufting height now adjusts to the depth of the lines in the digital rendering and creates structure of various pile heights - a 3D piece for your floor.

PRODUCT TYPE: Tufted

COMPOSITION: 100% NZ Wool 380/1 tex

COLOUR: choose 1 colour

FINISH: contoured cut pile, shorn and carved

PILE HEIGHT: 10-25 mm

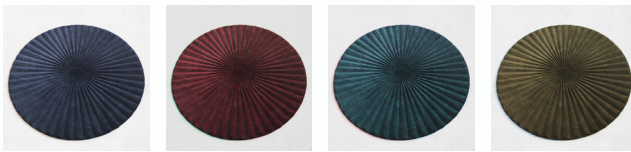
TOTAL HEIGHT: approx. 28 mm

TOTAL YARN WEIGHT: approx. 3.6 kg/m²

BACKING MATERIAL: Polypropylene, Action back

ADHESIVE: Latex

EDGING: Standard rolled edge and tape



SIZE

Sunburst rug is available in the custom size of your choice, from 1800 mm diameter to 3600 mm diameter.



MOST COMMON RUG SIZES are 2000 mm diameter, 2500 mm diameter, 3000 mm diameter

CARE ADVICE

It is common for every new wool rug to shed fibers so please do not be alarmed. The majority of the shedding will occur in the first few months. Do not rub fresh stains as rubbing only pushes the stain deeper into the fibers. Make sure to attend to any spills immediately, and blot up liquids with plenty of paper towels. Regular vacuuming is the most efficient way to remove surface dust and prevent build-up of material that could harm the carpet. We recommend cleaning the carpet by professional carpet cleaners every 18 months. Cleaning by hot water extraction (steam cleaning) can produce excellent results provided that it is carried out by a competent operator.

Make sure to rotate rugs regularly to ensure even wear and protect them from prolonged periods of direct sunlight.

COLOUR

Custom colour of your choice.

DISCLAIMER

Dimensions may vary by up to 3% due to the tufting process so please specify the maximum or minimum dimensions when ordering the carpet or rug. For carpet installation, please allow extra 5-10% for fitting tolerance, depending on the room's size and shape.

Please note that variations in colour and texture may occur between batches of yarn and dye baths. All carpets and rugs, irrespective of their colour or finish, are subjected to shading and cut pile carpets may be subject to pile reversal which is not a manufacturing fault, but an inherent characteristic of these flooring surfaces.
